

DIGITAL THEOLOGICAL LIBRARY (DTL)

INSTITUTIONAL EBOOK CLICK-THROUGH LICENSE AGREEMENT (perpetual license)

By clicking “**I Agree**”, the individual accepting this Agreement represents and warrants that they are authorized to bind the institution identified below (“**Licensee**”) and agrees, on behalf of the Licensee, to the following terms and conditions.

If you do not agree to these terms, do not proceed with the purchase or activation of access.

1. Parties

This Agreement is between:

Digital Theological Library (DTL) (“**Licensor**”),

and

the academic or theological library or institution completing this transaction (“**Licensee**”).

2. Licensed Content

“**Licensed Content**” means the digital books and related materials published by DTL and made available to Licensee through this transaction.

All Licensed Content is protected by copyright and remains the exclusive property of Licensor.

3. Authorized Users

“**Authorized Users**” are limited to:

- (a) currently enrolled students of the Licensee;
- (b) current faculty, staff, and employees of the Licensee; and
- (c) walk-in patrons who are physically present within the Licensee’s library facilities.

4. Grant of License

Licensor grants Licensee a **non-exclusive, non-transferable, non-sublicensable license** to provide access to the Licensed Content solely to Authorized Users for purposes of research, teaching, learning, and private study.

No ownership rights are transferred.

5. Permitted Uses

Authorized Users may:

- Access, view, download, and read the Licensed Content.
- Download or print the Licensed Content for personal, non-commercial academic use.
- Use the Licensed Content in course materials, reserves, presentations, or learning management systems, provided access is limited to Authorized Users and proper attribution is given.

6. Access Controls and Restrictions

Licensee agrees to:

6.1 Make every reasonable effort to limit access to the Licensed Content to Authorized Users.

6.2 Use secure authentication methods (e.g., IP authentication, proxy servers, or institutional login systems) to prevent unauthorized access.

6.3 Permit access for walk-in patrons only while they are physically present within the library.

6.4 Refrain from making the Licensed Content openly available on the public internet or through unrestricted networks.

7. Prohibited Uses

Licensee and Authorized Users shall not:

- Redistribute, resell, sublicense, or systematically reproduce the Licensed Content.
- Allow bulk downloading or automated harvesting.
- Remove or alter copyright notices.
- Use the Licensed Content for commercial purposes.

8. Copyright Compliance

Licensee acknowledges Licensor's copyright in the Licensed Content and agrees to:

- Inform Authorized Users of appropriate use restrictions; and
- Take reasonable steps to address known or reported misuse.

Upon notice of misuse from Licensor, Licensee will promptly investigate and take corrective action.

9. Term and Termination

Access to the Licensed Content is provided for the term specified at the time of purchase or activation.

Licensor may suspend or terminate access in the event of material breach that remains uncured after reasonable notice.

10. Disclaimer and Limitation of Liability

The Licensed Content is provided “**as is.**” Licensor makes no warranties regarding accuracy or fitness for a particular purpose.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Licensor shall not be liable for indirect, incidental, or consequential damages.

11. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the **State of California**, without regard to conflict-of-law principles.

12. Acceptance

By clicking “**I Agree**”, Licensee confirms acceptance of this Agreement and represents that the individual accepting has authority to bind the Licensee.
